**Conditions of the Scheme:**

- ❖ Tipperary County Council is offering two bursaries to attend this year's summer school at the University of Limerick. The value of the bursary covers 1 week's tuition (includes lectures, workshops, assessment and attendance at all concerts). The purpose of these bursaries is to support professional development of artists. Travel arrangements and accommodation (if required) are the responsibility of the applicant.
- ❖ **Applicants must be resident in the Tipperary administrative area.**
- ❖ Applicants must have achieved intermediate level of proficiency in their chosen area at a minimum e.g. (music/song/dance)
- ❖ Payment of the bursaries will be made directly to the Blás International Summer School of Irish Traditional Music and Dance.
- ❖ Applicants must be age 16 years + (by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2019) (if under 18 years, written permission of parent/guardian to attend must be submitted at application stage)
