**Conditions of the Scheme:**

- ❖ Tipperary County Council is offering two bursaries to attend this year's virtual summer school at the University of Limerick. The value of the bursary covers 1 week's tuition (one-week intensive of masterclasses, Irish language, lectures and concerts). The purpose of these bursaries is to support professional development of artists.
- ❖ **Applicants must be resident in the Tipperary administrative area.**
- ❖ Applicants must have achieved intermediate level of proficiency in their chosen area at a minimum e.g. (music/song/dance)
- ❖ Payment of the bursaries will be made directly to the Blas International Summer School of Irish Traditional Music and Dance.
- ❖ Applicants must be age 16 years + (by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2021) (if under 18 years, written permission of parent/guardian to attend must be submitted at application stage)
