The student must also complete a written assignment due for submission after the Blas programme is complete (date TBC in August 2023). While the University of Limerick provides accreditation to the successful student, Blas cannot guarantee that this accreditation will be recognised by your home institution. The onus is on the individual to request and confirm that this accreditation is recognised by the relevant institution at which they study full time. Students who only register for one week of Blas will not be eligible for accreditation.
